MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

FELLOW (FIQ)

The higher corporate grade for those who have the necessary qualifications and senior managerial experience (see overleaf for exact requirements). This grade carries the right to the designatory letters FIQ.



MEMBER (MIQ)

The standard grade of membership for those with an approved qualification and basic line management or specialist experience in the industry (see overleaf for exact requirements). Designatory letters MIQ.



TECHNICIAL MEMBER (TMIQ)

This grade is open to those providing specific technical services to the industry, possessing an appropriate employment related qualification and have in excess of one years experience undertaking a technical role.

The grade carries the designation of TMIQ.



This category is for those persons having experience of the industry but without formal qualifications and those working towards a qualification or gaining experience.



A subsidised grade for individuals undertaking full time study, who are working towards a qualification recognised within the extractives/mineral processing sector.

Progression through the grades of membership is shown above, however, direct entry into any grade is possible, provided that the applicant has the necessary qualifications and experience (see overleaf).

Membership Requirements

CORPORATE GRADES

FELLOW

- (a) must be employed in the industry
- (b) have met the Membership requirements (see below)
- (c) have at least seven years' experience in the industry, including four years in the position of senior managerial charge
- (d) must include a current c.v. and copies of certificates with application

MEMBER

- (a) must be employed in the industry
- (b) have passed the Diploma in Quarry Technology from the University of Derby or possess a qualifying exempting qualification
- (c) have completed a period of training and experience in the industry, of which not less than three years was in a position of responsible charge
- (d) must include copies of certificates with application

NOTE

Inspectors of mines and quarries are exempt from the requirements (c) for Fellow and Member grades, provided that they hold an appropriate level of experience in the inspectorate as determined in the absolute discretion of the Council.

NON-CORPORATE GRADES

TECHNICIAN

- (a) must be employed in the industry, or employed as a contractor/ supplier working in the industry
- (b) Possess a qualifying qualification, or combination of qualifications, relevant to their employment
- (c) have completed a period of training and have experience in the industry, of which is in excess of one year in a technical postion
- (d) must include copies of certificates with application

ASSOCIATE

(a) must be employed in the industry, or employed as a contractor/ supplier working in the industry

NOTE

Mature candidates' rights are available to Associates who have 10 years' experience in the industry, including five years in a position of managerial charge. The applicant can qualify for the corporate grades of Fellow or Member through the preparation of a thesis.

STUDENT

 (a) must be engaged in a recognised full time course of study or training relating to the industry

NOTE

Students must upgrade membership upon completion of course of study.

Guidelines

'The Quarrying Industry': the extraction and processing of minerals, including secondary minerals, recycled materials, crushed and dimension stone, sand and gravel, clays, opencast coal, asphalt, cement, readymixed concrete and concrete products, plus companies supplying goods and services to the quarrying industry.

Mines and quarries inspectors, drilling and blasting contractors, lecturers in quarrying at recognised colleges, technical consultants and minerals planning officers are regarded as being employed within the industry.

'Experience in the Industry': full time employment in the industry, including industrial periods of approved courses.

'Senior managerial charge': in charge of a significant operation; an area or regional manager; a recognised senior staff appointment; head of a department, etc.

'Position of responsible charge': appointments such as quarry manager or assistant manager; a person in charge of a section of a quarry or associated plant; those in recognised technical, administrative or sales appointments.

'Exempting qualification': an approved technical or administrative qualification. Refer to local branch secretary or website www.quarrying.org for further clarification.

'Technical qualification': an academic qualification approved by Council at not less than HNC Level appropriate to the person's discipline, eg: HNC Civil Engineering, HND Mechanical Engineering, BSc Geology.

'Administrative qualification': an academic qualification approved by Council at not less than HND Level appropriate to the person's discipline' eg: HNC Business Studies, Diploma in Management Studies, BA Town and Country Planning.
